REHOMING ASSISTANT

KGR are looking to recruit a volunteer, who would enjoy the challenge of helping KGR find new homes for the greyhounds and lurchers in its care.

Location: Primarily at kennels near High Halstow in Medway. Please note you will need to drive for this role as there is no public transport.

Time Commitment: Around 7 hours per week and would suit an individual with good inter personal & organisational skills.

Key Tasks:

- Dog socialising at kennels
- Arranging dog walks for volunteers from the kennels
- Providing photos and write ups from the walks for social media.
- Completing the adoption process, by meeting the new family at the kennels, ensuring all the paperwork is correct and finalising the adoption.
- Carry out follow up calls at set intervals after adoption.

Skills Needed

- Excellent telephone manner and written communication skills
- Outgoing, friendly and proactive character.
- Good understanding of dogs and dog behavior.
- Fully computer literate and comfortable with the main Microsoft Office tools, databases and emails.
- Be comfortable volunteering within a group or by yourself.
- No formal rehoming or kennel experience is necessary.
